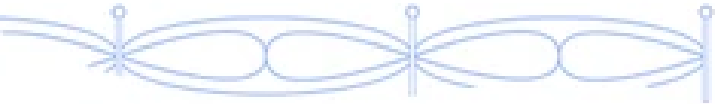


SNOW REMOVAL REGULATIONS

For Property Owners and Managers



DUTIES OF OWNERS OR MANAGERS OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES

- Every owner, occupant or person in charge of a residential building or vacant lot shall clear snow from the sidewalks surrounding their property to allow the passage of pedestrians and strollers.
- Snow must be removed **within 8 hours after snowfall**. If snow has fallen overnight, snow must be removed within 8 hour after sunrise.

Jersey City Code of Ordinances Chapter 296, Article 1.1

DUTIES OF OWNERS OR MANAGERS OF COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES

- Every owner, occupant or person in charge of a commercial building or vacant lot shall clear snow from the sidewalks surrounding their property to allow the passage of pedestrians and strollers.
- Snow must be removed **within 4 hours after snowfall**. If snow has fallen overnight, snow must be removed within 8 hour after sunrise.

Jersey City Code of Ordinances Chapter 296, Article 1.2

IT IS ILLEGAL TO DUMP SNOW IN THE STREET

- After the snowstorm, no person shall shovel, throw or deposit any snow or ice from a sidewalk or gutter after the street has been plowed by the City.
- All snow and ice removed from the sidewalk shall be banked and piled within three feet inside the curb.
