Intent of Specifications:

It is the intent of the Jersey City Department of Public Safety, Division of Fire "JCFD" to purchase 20 commercially produced FLIR-65 NFPA 1801-2018 ed. Thermal Imaging Camera "TIC" systems, associated hardware and software for utilization during firefighting and hazardous material operations and 40 FLIR K-1 personal assessment cameras. The specified TIC shall serve as an adjunct tool for Fire operations to include but not limited to, structural fire size up, fire rescue, fire suppression, rapid intervention, overhaul, wildland firefighting, search and rescue.

The specifications herein shall serve as a minimum standard necessary to safely and effectively accomplish the aforementioned operational requirements.

- 1) The TIC system delivered to these specifications shall be a nationally available standard commercial product. Experimental or prototype cameras shall not be considered.
- 2) Materials used in construction of the TIC system shall be new, unused, and not less than the quality conforming to modern engineering and manufacturing practices. Materials shall be free of defects and suitable for the service intended.
- 3) The TIC shall be from a single source manufacturer. For the purposes of this specification, single source shall mean the camera product is manufactured/assembled and serviced by the manufacturer. Warranty/Service facilities shall be owned and operated by the single source manufacturer.
- 4) Exceptions and "Equal to" proposals
 - a. Any bid submitted that proposes an "Equal to" product shall include sufficient detailed technical documentation for the JCFD to determine "Equal to" standing. The JCFD reserves the right to require additional information. "Equal to" status shall be granted solely at the discretion and in opinion of the JCFD.
 - b. The term "no exceptions" shall indicate items where substitutions/non-compliance will not be allowed
 - c. All exceptions shall be clearly identified and listed with the proposal. Failure to identify list exceptions shall be considered as unresponsive to these specifications and cause for rejection
 - d. Any proposal taking full exception to this specification shall not be considered responsive and shall be rejected.






