The contract will be awarded in accordance with the provisions of the City's Disclosure of Lobbyist Representative Status Ordinance 3-9.1 et seq. adopted on June 12, 2002. The Contractor will be required to certify that the Contractor either did not retain the services of a lobbyist to lobby on behalf of the Contractor for the award of this contract, or if a lobbyist was retained by the Contractor for such purposes, the Contractor's lobbyist prior to commencing his/her lobbying activities, shall have filed a notice of lobbyist representative status form with the City Clerk. A Contractor whose lobbyist failed to comply with the provisions of Ordinance 3-9.1 et. seq. following notice and an opportunity to be heard, shall be disqualified from entering into contracts with the City for a period of two (2) years for each violation.

6. Insurance Requirements

The Respondent shall maintain sufficient insurance to protect against all claims under Workmen's Commercial General Liability and Automobile Liability and shall be subject to approval for adequacy of protection. Certificates of such insurance, naming the City of Jersey City as an additional insured for Commercial General Liability coverage shall be provided. Insurance requirements are as follows:

- a. Commercial General Liability in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence and \$2,000,000.00 in aggregate, including Products and Completed Operations coverage.
- b. Workers Compensation with NJ statutory limits and Employer's Liability in the amount of \$1,000,000.00.
- c. Automobile Liability in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit.

<u>Proof of Business Registration</u> - <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 52:32-44 requires that each bidder (contractor) submit proof of business registration with the bid proposal or prior to the contract award. Proof of registration shall be a copy of the bidder's Business Registration Certificate (BRC). A BRC is obtained from the New Jersey Division of Revenue. Information on obtaining a BRC is available on the internet at www.nj.gov/njbgs or by phone at 609-292-1730. N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 imposes the following requirements on contractors and all subcontractors that **knowingly** provide goods or perform services for a contractor fulfilling this contract:




The contractor shall provide written notice to its subcontractors of the responsibility to submit proof of business registration to the contractor.

Before final payment on the contract is made by the contracting agency, the contractor shall submit an accurate list and the proof of business registration of each subcontractor or supplier used in the fulfillment of the contract, or shall attest that no subcontractors were used.

For the term of the contract, the contractor and each of its affiliates and a subcontractor and each of its affiliates [NJ.SA 52:32-44(g) (3)] shall collect and remit to the Director, New Jersey Division of Taxation, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Act on all sales of tangible personal property delivered into this State, regardless of whether the tangible personal property is intended for a contract with a contracting agency.

A business organization that fails to provide a copy of a business registration as required pursuant to section 1 of P.L.2001, c.i34 (C.52:32-44 et al.) or subsection e. or f. of section 92 of P.L.1977, c.110 (C.5: 12-92), or that provides false business registration information under the requirements of either of those sections, shall be liable for a penalty of \$25 for each day of violation, not to exceed \$50,000 for each business registration copy not properly provided under a contract with a contracting agency."




