

Driver License Restoration

Description

To restore a New Jersey driver's license:

- You must first pay, at the Violations Bureau, the unpaid fines & costs, which were the reason for your suspension
- Then you must go to the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (NJMVC) with the receipt from the Violations Bureau to have your license restored. A license restoration fee will be charged by the MVC.

PLEASE NOTE: Once your license is suspended, you must personally appear at the Violations Bureau to pay your outstanding fine. It cannot be paid by mail.
